

I – PASS Training

Purpose

To improve patient safety and handoff communication, **St. Elizabeth Healthcare** is working with the I-PASS Institute to roll out an implementation of the I-PASS handoff method.

You have been set up with an account to access the I-PASS Training modules.

- ❖ This interactive training is intended to not only introduce the core I-PASS concepts, but also to apply the concepts in a virtual simulation experience that will require you to compose both verbal and written handoffs. You have been assigned a practice patient with clinical content that should be relevant to you. There are three sections to this module: Intro, Handoff, and Synthesis.
- ❖ Please make sure that you have time to complete each section of the module in one sitting (Intro -10 min, Handoff -25 min, and Synthesis -15 min). If step away and do not complete the Handoff or Synthesis module, it will not save your progress and you will need to start the section over.

- ❖ On the next slide you will be directed to the I-PASS Training site to access the modules.
- ❖ You will need speakers and a microphone to access parts of the module. Most laptops will work just fine, but a headset or earbuds with a mic at a desktop computer will work as well.
- ❖ Once you have completed all three sections of the module in the I-PASS training environment, return to CMECloud and complete the post-test and HARMs to Patient Survey.
